

dense (adjective)

Meaning: to be closely packed together

The children approached the **dense** forest.

carve(d) (verb)

Meaning: to cut through a solid material to form something

The river **carved** a pattern in the landscape.

plazoom

admire (verb)

Meaning: to look at with wonder, pleasure or approval

They stopped to **admire** the view.

plazoom

smother (verb)

Meaning: to thickly cover or stifle an object

The thick mist was **smothering** the trees in white.

plazoom

purse(d) (verb)

Meaning: to pucker your lips

The teacher **pursed** her lips
as the children misbehaved.

plazoom

weary (adjective)

Meaning: exhausted
(very tired)

They continued up the
mountain on their **weary** legs.

plazoom

pillar (noun)

Meaning: a tall slim structure often made of brick or concrete

In the middle of the clearing stood a **pillar** of concrete.

plazoom

strew(n) (verb)

Meaning: scatter or sprinkle

The field was **strewn** with rocks.

plazoom

mountain (noun)

Meaning: a natural area of high land, much taller than a hill

We have reached the top of the **mountain**.

plazoom

glacier (noun)

Meaning: a large area of thick ice that stays frozen from one year to the next

Thousands of years ago, large parts of the world were covered in **glaciers**.

plazoom

summit (noun)

Meaning: the highest point of a mountain

“We’ve reached the **summit** of the mountain,” Kenny said, excitedly.

plazoom

peak (noun)

Meaning: the pointed top of a mountain

They could see the **peak** of the mountain from the window.

plazoom

valley (noun)

Meaning: a ditch in the Earth's surface, usually between hills or mountains

A river runs through the **valley**.

plazoom

forest (noun)

Meaning: a large area of land covered with trees

The paths led into the dense **forest**.

plazoom

plateau (noun)

Meaning: a raised land area with a level surface

They found themselves standing on a flat **plateau** covered in rocks.

plazoom

mist (noun)

Meaning: a thin fog near to the ground

A thick **mist** covered the landscape.

plazoom

Trig Point (noun)

Meaning: a point used in map making, often marked by a stone pillar

“That’s a **Trig Point**,” Kenny said.

compass (noun)

Meaning: equipment to show directions

I can use my map and **compass** to help me find my way.

foreign (adjective)

Meaning: something or someone that belongs or is coming from a different place or country

he was speaking a
foreign language.
